1. What the student learnt this week:

- Distance between a point and a line
- Practiced how to solve word problems
- Mostly reviewed concepts in preparation for final test

2. What I think about the challenges (personal, technical) the student faces in Math: Ashley is starting to piece together concepts and solve familiar problems independently. However, she often overthinks things, and sometimes fails to see an answer that's in plain sight. Other problems include sign errors in algebraic work, or skipping lines in her shown work, though these are relatively minor.

3. What I can do (next week) to help the student overcome these challenges:

Unfortunately, next day is now the final day of tutoring, so it is now time for her to show what she's learned on a final test. I can clarify any possible confusion in word problems, to help make the test easier to understand. I can also go over the test after it has been completed to help point out mistakes that have been made, and areas of possible improvement.

4. Any other information / comments / points of view that should be discussed in this report:

Ashley has progressed well over the course of two months. She retains information from past sessions well, and shows flexible thinking in her problem solving(though, that being said, she would do well if she kept focus to prevent problem solving strategies from becoming outlandish). Ashley shows more consistency with her algebra, solving reasonably complicated problems, but should work to minimize sign errors in her work(a problem, that plagues us all, honestly).
